Description of Building Product

PSP Limited supplies Suntuf EZ Glaze (EZ Glaze) Polycarbonate Roofing.

EZ Glaze is intended as an exterior roofing system for open-sided porches, verandas, or free-standing structures. The polycarbonate panels are manufactured by <u>Palram</u>. Palram is an Israeli company that was founded in 1963 and supplies thermoplastic products globally.

Polycarbonate is a hard, dimensionally rigid plastic with good impact resistance and flexibility. The clear sheets have 90% light transmission while providing UV protection. The application of a co-extruded UV protective layer on one side protects the sheeting from yellowing.

The polycarbonate roofing panels are fixed to timber rafters using PSP's Suntuf stainless steel fixings with EPDM washers.
