


## PROFILE OPTIONS

Metalcraft Fencing is available in 2 popular profiles. The Aztec profile offers a wide pan for a sleeker cleaner look and Kāhu® offers a contemporary symetrical profile that looks great from both sides of the fence.

#### AZTEC PROFILE

Aztec has strong defined lines. The Aztec profile has a raised five rib trapezoid form on one side, and a flat aspect on the other. Aztec is a very popular profile that will complement any home or project. Manufactured from double sided 0.35BMT G550 Colorsteel® Endura®. Standard fence height of 1.8m. Custom heights are also available.



Dimensions are nominal and may vary. Check with your nearest Metalcraft Fencing branch for profile dimensions.

### KĀHU® PROFILE

A contemporary look with strong defined shadow lines. The Kāhu® profile has a high rib symmetrical profile which looks great from either side of the fence. Manufactured from double sided 0.40BMT G550 Colorsteel® Endura®. Standard fence height of 1.8m. Custom heights are also available.



Dimensions are nominal and may vary. Check with your nearest Metalcraft Fencing branch for profile dimensions.

#### POST AND RAILS

An innovative roll formed post and rail system offers the dual benefit of strength and ease of installation. A key advantage of this fencing system is that our steel posts and rails are robust enough to eliminate the need for any intermediate rails, affording clean lines and a tidy look on both sides of the fence.

The post and rails are manufactured from double sided 0.75BMT G550 galvanised steel from New Zealand Steel and are available as standard in the same colours as the fence. If you want you can also request post and rails in another complementary colour to the metal fence panels. Refer to the 6 stocked colours for options.

#### RANGE OF GATES

Metalcraft Roofing has a range of gates to complement the standard range of Metalcraft fencing and accessories. Please contact your local Metalcraft Branch for more information.

#### POOLSIDE & BARRIER FENCE

# METAL FENCING

#### STEP BY STEP INSTALLATION

Metalcraft fencing is simple to install. Posts are screwed together back to back before being secured in position, which gives them considerable strength in the ground. The rail sections are designed to slip inside the post profile snugly to ensure a good fit, then screwed in place to retain the infill panels. Our posts and rails are prepainted to your requirements and run in fixed lengths to simplify ordering and minimise labour on site. Easy installation videos available: www.metalcraftgroup.co.nz

- 1 Set the string line
- 2 Mark the post holes
- 3 Dig the post holes
- 4 Assemble intermediate posts
- 5 Erect end posts
- 6 Cement end posts
- 7 Reset the stringline for intermediate posts
- 8 Erect intermediate posts
- 9 Insert and fasten bottom rails
- 10 Drop in infill panels
- 11 Insert and fasten top rails








