


## **BE365 Door Preparation Instructions For Door With Existing Holes**


## **Tools Needed**













**Measure Door Width** 

If the door is thinner than 1%" or thicker than 13/4", then the lock will not fit properly on the door.



If Needed, Enlarge Hole in Door Edge

If hole in door edge is smaller than 1", then use 1" drill bit to enlarge hole.




**Measure for Backset** 

If existing backset is not 23/8" or 23/4", then the lock will not fit properly on the door.

**Measure Hole Sizes** 






If hole sizes are larger than those shown, then the lock will not fit

Check Strike (Door Jamb) Preparation

- a. Place new strike box and strike against door jamb.
- b. If strike box and strike do not fit properly, use pencil to trace around strike box and strike and mark hole positions.
- c. If needed, use chisel and drill to correct door jamb preparation.





If Needed, Enlarge **Hole in Door** 

If hole in door is smaller than 21/8", then use 21/8" hole saw to enlarge hole.
